ISO Sugar Yearbook Questionnaire Reminder

I have to remind all the member-states that, according to Article 32 (item 2) of the ISA 1992, "Members undertake to supply within the time which may be prescribed in the rules of procedure all available statistics and information as may be identified in those rules as necessary to enable the Organization to discharge its function under this agreement."

On 18th January 2023 the Secretariat sent the Sugar Yearbook Questionnaire with Memo(23)06 requesting the statistics for the calendar year 2022. The **deadline** for returning the questionnaire **was the 31st March 2023**. However, we have not yet received statistics from a significant number of members.
