UNITED KINGDOM - AG Barr readies for tax as sugar becomes top concern

A survey conducted by the Food Standards Agency in the UK found that sugar content has become the number one concern surrounding food safety issues, with 56% of respondent ranking it as their top concern. The other top concerns were, in order, food prices, food waste and animal welfare. Soft drinks maker AG Barr said 99% of its products will escape the sugar tax, which kicks in from April, as they contain less than 5g/100ml of sugar, while the firm reported positive feedback on its low sugar version of the Irn-Bru drink.
