SOUTH AFRICA - Sugar tax extends to all sweetened beverages

South Africa's recently introduced sugar tax extends to any drinks that contain sweeteners, including non-caloric sweeteners, according to a consultant at Mazars, who noted that this was unlike most other sugar taxes around the world. Diet drinks, non-alcoholic beers, and aerated waters will be taxed, although drinks that contain natural sugars such as 100% fruit juice and unsweetened milk will be exempted.
