#### **WORLD - Nations challenge Gulf's sugar tax at WTO**

The US, the EU and Switzerland questioned the 100% tax on energy drinks and 50% tax on other soda beverages levied by Bahrain, Saudi Arabia and the UAE at the WTO. The US wants the tax to be withdrawn while Switzerland would like it to be modified. The EU argued that the tax was not justified by health concerns as it is based on price and does not apply to non-carbonated sweet drinks. ([Reuters](#))

#### **Portugal to reduce size of sugar sachets to tackle obesity**

Individual sugar sachets sold at supermarkets and used at cafés, bars and restaurants, will see their size reduced starting in little more than a year, according The Portugal News. According to the National Health Board, sachets will be reduced from their current quantity of five or six grams to four, starting from January 2020. The size of sachets had previously been reduced from eight to a maximum of six grams back in 2016.... [Read more...](#)
