EL SALVADOR: Sugarcane producers and mills looking to improve productivity

Mills in El Salvador have one of the highest productivity rates in Central America, but there is still room for improvement in agricultural yields, said Mario Salaverría, president of the local sugar industry association, according to La Prensa Grafica news website. Salvadoran sugarcane mills have an average productivity of 116 kilos of sugar per tonne of cane, but the country is in the fourth position in the ranking of agricultural productivity in Central America, at 83 tonnes of sugarcane...
