EU: MARS raises sugar beet yield estimates

The EU's crop monitoring service MARS lifted estimates for most spring crops which benefited from good weather conditions in its latest update on July 27, according to Reuters.

MARS said that the EU sugar beet yield was now expected at 75.9 tonnes/hectare, up from 75.5 tonnes/hectare estimated last month.

That is 1.8% above the five-year average.

Close-to-average weather conditions, with well distributed rainfall and relatively few hot spells, have been favourable to crops in many parts of Europe, it said.

USDA to add cane to GMO list - The National Law Review - The USDA proposed to add sugarcane to the list of crops that potentially require a bioengineered (BE) food disclosure, as it noted that a genetically modified cane variety was planted on 4,000ha in Brazil for the 2018/19 harvest. The proposal could impact firms hoping to avoid the requirement which is already imposed on beet sugar.
